Security Tips:

Over the last couple of weeks, I've received a rash of virused computers. While each of them had different viruses, most of them were variations on an older virus, Anti-Virus 20xx. In essence, the virus pops up a window on your machine stating some variation of the following:

ABC Anti-Virus has detected that your computer is infected and/or has 1,000 severe errors. Click this link or call this number to purchase our software and we'll fix your computer.

If you click the link or install their software, what you're really doing is installing the rest of the virus. If I get the machine early enough, I can clean the virus out. If not, this virus will corrupt Windows to the point where the only fix is to reinstall Windows. Some of the machines I've received have also had some of their data corrupted.

If you get a pop-up like this (or another one that you don't recognize), please don't hesitate to call me or email me. I can tell you if it's a normal update or if it's something that needs to be looked at.
